With an estimated 411,809 residents in 2024, Horry County is the 4th largest county in the state of South Carolina out of 46 counties. The estimated median *household* income of Horry County residents is \$59,880, however, 3.21% of *full-time* workers live in poverty. The median age of a Horry County resident is 47.6 years young; there are 89,825 seniors of which 17,993 are veterans over the age of 64 years. 6.15% of Horry County veterans live in poverty and 35.05% are disabled.
